Tuition for full-time students (in-state)	<p>\$495 per quarter hour for academic courses. \$3,265 for each extended seminar. \$275 for each Weekend-in-Residence course. \$2,725 per dissertation course.</p> <p>Total estimated program cost (pre-reqs completed prior to enrollment; but without credit for course transfers or grants) = \$81,005.²</p> <p><i>Expenses related to travel and lodging are not included in total estimate.</i></p>

Tuition per credit hour for part-time students (if applicable)	Same as above
University / institution fees or costs	\$50 one time application fee.
Additional estimated fees or costs to students (e.g. books, travel, etc.)	Additional expenses for the program include books (\$3,658), travel (\$3,500), and hotel (\$3,040) for the YiR.

² This program requires prerequisites that are not listed as required courses, which may increase the total number of courses required to complete the Clinical PsyD program. Costs may be higher for students needing to take prerequisites or who do not transfer in 15 credits. Tuition for 2012-2013 may range from \$73,580 (all pre-reqs completed and 15 transfer credits) to \$93,380 (no pre-reqs completed and 0 transfer credits).
