

2022 CACREP Program/Learner Outcomes: MS in CLINICAL MENTAL HEALTH COUNSELING

- *Clinical Mental Health Counseling Graduates have a 41% pass rate on the National Clinical Mental Health Counseling Exam.* Exam pass rates are based on reports from the National Board of Certified Counselors on statistics for self-reported Capella alumni taking the National Mental Health Counselor Examination (NCMHCE) Fall 2021. Capella is notified of exam scores by the exam proctor only if the exam takers identify Capella as a recipient of their scores. Out of 51 CMHC learners that took the NCMHCE, 21 passed.
- *Clinical Mental Health Counseling Graduates have a 74% pass rate on the National Counseling Exam.* Exam pass rates are based on reports from the National Board of Certified Counselors on statistics for self-reported Capella alumni taking the National Counselor Exam (NCE) in Fall 2021 and Spring 2022. Capella is notified of exam scores by the exam proctor only if the exam takers identify Capella as a recipient of their scores. Out of 207 CMHC graduates who took the NCE, 154 passed.
- *486 learners graduated from the Clinical Mental Health Counseling program between 2021-2022 academic year.*
- *The completion rate for learners from the Clinical Mental Health Counseling program is 52%.* Completion rate is the percentage of those learners from 2015-2016 and 2016-2017 cohorts (learners who register for a second course in the year specified) who finished their degree within 24 quarters. Within this group, out of 1,662 Clinical Mental Health Counseling learners, 857 graduated within 24 quarters.
- *Capella does not offer job placement assistance. Data for job placement were gathered from a survey distributed to alumni who graduated from Capella's CACREP-accredited programs in 2021. Fewer than 10 percent of MS in Clinical Mental Health Counseling alumni responded, resulting in a statistically insignificant response rate.*
