

2022 CACREP Program/Learner Outcomes: MS in SCHOOL COUNSELING

- *School Counseling Graduates have a 74% pass rate on the National Counseling Exam.* Exam pass rates are based on reports from the National Board of Certified Counselors on statistics for self-reported Capella alumni taking the NCE exam in Fall 2021 and Spring 2022. Capella is notified of exam scores by the exam proctor only if the exam takers identify Capella as a recipient of their scores. Out of 43 SC graduates that took the NCE exam, 32 passed.
- *School Counseling Graduates have an 85% pass rate on the Praxis Exam.* Exam pass rates are based on reports from school counseling learners who have taken the Praxis exam in the 2021 – 2022 academic year. Out of 13 SC graduates that took the Praxis exam, 11 passed.
- *214 learners graduated from the School Counseling program in the 2021 – 2022 academic year.*
- *The current completion rate for learners from the School Counseling program is 60%.* Completion rate is the percentage of those learners from 2015-2016 and 2016-2017 cohorts (learners who register for a second course in the year specified and complete their degree) who finished their degree within 24 quarters. Within this group, out of 659 School Counseling learners, 395 graduated within 24 quarters.
- Capella does not offer job placement assistance. Data for job placement was gathered from a survey distributed to alumni who graduated from Capella's MS in School Counseling program in 2021. The survey asked "Upon graduating from your Capella graduate counseling program, have you obtained new employment or advanced in your position within the counseling field?" This survey question yielded a 19.7% response rate. Please note that this question does not gather placement rate data exclusively, but also collects information about alumni who advanced in positions they already held. Capella reports this information to meet accreditor requirements. Due to the limited data set and time frame underpinning this data, the information here should not be used as an indicator of the likelihood of any Capella graduate obtaining a job, promotion, or other career advancement. *86% of the School Counseling graduates who responded to the survey indicated they obtained new employment or advanced in their position within the counseling field within 180 days of graduation.*
