

2023-2024 CACREP Program/Student Outcomes: MS in Clinical Mental Health Counseling

- MS in Clinical Mental Health Counseling (CMHC) graduates have an 87% pass rate on the National Clinical Mental Health Counseling Exam (NCMHCE). Exam pass rates are based on reports from the National Board of Certified Counselors on statistics for self-reported Capella alumni taking the NCMHCE in Fall 2023 with no alumni reporting in Spring 2024. Capella is notified of exam scores by the exam proctor only if the exam takers identify Capella as a recipient of their scores. Out of 8 CMHC students that took the NCMHCE, 7 passed.
- CMHC graduates have an 83% pass rate on the National Counselor Exam (NCE). Exam
 pass rates are based on reports from the National Board of Certified Counselors on
 statistics for self-reported Capella alumni taking the NCE in Fall 2023 and Spring
 2024. Capella is notified of exam scores by the exam proctor only if the exam takers
 identify Capella as a recipient of their scores. Out of 128 CMHC graduates who took
 the NCE, 107 passed.
- 480 students graduated from the CMHC program between 2023-2024 academic year.
- The completion rate for students from the CMHC program is 54%. Completion rate is the percentage 2016-2017 and 2017-2018 cohorts (students who register for a second course in the year specified) who finished their degree within 24 quarters. Within this group, out of 1406 CMHC students, 763 graduated within 24 quarters.
- Capella does not offer job placement assistance. Data for job placement were gathered
 from a survey distributed to alumni who graduated from Capella's CACREP-accredited
 programs in 2023. 88% of CMHC alumni that responded to the survey had obtained new
 employment or advanced in their position within the counseling field upon graduating
 from the program.
