Capella's MS in Clinical Psychology, Clinical Counseling program is not accredited by CACREP or an equivalent accrediting body and will not lead to LMHC licensure after July 1st, 2025.					
Current learners enrolled in the MS in Clinical Psychology, Clinical Counseling program seeking a LMHC license in Florida should plan to complete the program including the required additional courses, practicum and/or internship hours to meet the state's requirements for licensure and apply to the state for licensure prior to July 1st, 2025.
