## Official Transcript: Welcome to the FlexPath Courseroom

My name's Nacole Riccaboni (title card on screen: Nacole Riccaboni, 2019 MBA FlexPath Student), and today we're going to look at the FlexPath Trial Course. First, when you go to the FlexPath Trial Course, you're going to see the competency map. I use a competency map to look at my assessments and to check my progress through a course. It's kind of a motivator. If it's green, I know I'm doing well. If it's red, I'm not doing well, but it keeps you on track and focus. FlexPath is not built on deadlines. It's built on target dates that you set and adjust based on your work schedule and your lifestyle (On-screen disclaimer: Actual FlexPath graduate compensated for appearing in Capella promotional materials).

You create your own timeline within the course. What I do is I read the assessment criteria and I determine how much time that assessment's going to take me. If it's a smaller assessment, I know I can get it done in one to two weeks. If it's a larger assessment, it might take me a month, but that's the flexibility that FlexPath offers you. Whether it's me being a mother or a nurse, I'm able to balance all that while also achieving my professional goals. Let's review an assessment. I look at the overview. I get the information. I look at the resources that are available to me. The resources reinforce the overview and assist you in completing the assessment.

I'm able to have the rubric right by my side and start that assignment within five to 10 minutes. It's a very seamless process. Everything in that assessment is in that window for you to view and be successful. The assessment submission process is exactly the same for every single class. You click submit, you submit your document, you click submit again, and that's it. It's a very seamless process. It takes maybe two to three minutes to submit an assignment. You have three attempts, and your highest grade is what's going to be recorded.

You're assigned an academic team, and that includes the course instructor and your advisor. The course instructor is an instructor for that class, so that obviously change with each course that you progress and succeed in. I never feel alone with the FlexPath program.

With FlexPath, I'm setting my schedule around my life. I love FlexPath. I love it. I look at my assessments. I look at my overview, and I get excited.
